

Phillipsburg Invitational Track Meet

Thursday, April 18, 2019

The Trojan track teams traveled to Phillipsburg for the Phillipsburg Invitational track meet held on Thursday, April 18. This meet saw the Trojans run up against some very tough competition from the likes of Phillipsburg, Norton, Smith Center, Concordia, and Russell.

The Trojan boy's brought home a total of 24 medals (3 gold, 17 silver, 4 bronze) and won the meet with 145 points. Smith Center was second with 127 points and Norton was third with 107 points.

The gold medal winners for Beloit were Vincent Palin in the triple jump at 41'5.75" and the 110m high hurdles in 15.76, and Zach Meier in the 300m hurdles in 42.69.

The silver medal winners were Jace Walker in the 100m dash in 11.61, Jacob Porter in the 3200m run in 11:25.69, Zach Meier in the 110m high hurdles in 15.83, Brennan Walker in the high jump at 5'4", Trase McQueen in the triple jump at 38'10.25", the 4X100m relay team of Zach Meier, Vincent Palen, Trase McQueen, and Jace Walker in 46.42, the 4X400m relay team of Vincent Palen, Tristan Brummer, Trase McQueen, and Zach Meier in 3:43.44, and the 4X800m relay team of Daniel Reyes, Jacob Porter, Bryce Mason, and Tristan Brummer in 9:18.56.

The bronze medal winners were Trase McQueen in the 400m run in 56.34, Tristan Brummer in the 1600m run in 5:18.4, Chance Kopsa in the 3200m run in 11:57.0, and Bryce Mason in the Javelin at 159'7".

The Lady Trojans brought home a total of 9 medals (4 gold, 3 silver, 2 bronze) and finished 3rd with 113.5 points. Norton won the meet with 149 points and Phillipsburg was second with 139 points.

The gold medal winners for Beloit were Blaise Spangler in the pole vault at 10'6", Halle Budke in the high jump at 5'0", Hayley Burks in the 3200m run in 12:57.52, and Gracie Wessling in the 100m hurdles in 17.96.

The silver medal winners were Hayley Burks in the 1600m run in 5:45.12, Khyllie Mihm in the 300m hurdles in 51.73, and Avery Johnson in the discus at 99'1".

The bronze medal winners were Caleigh Hewitt in the pole vault at 9'6" and Sage Prochaska in the discus at 97'5".

The next action for the Beloit Trojan varsity track teams will be the 79th annual Beloit Relays on Friday, April 26. Field events will start at 10:00am, preliminaries at 11:00am followed by the 3200m run and the running event finals.
