

SMITH CENTER REDMAN RELAYS

Tuesday, April 9, 2019

The Beloit Trojan track teams traveled to Smith Center for the Redman Relays on Tuesday, April 9. Participating at the meet were schools from Beloit, Phillipsburg, Republic County, Pike Valley, Marysville, Thunder Ridge, St. Johns, Southern Cloud, and Smith Center.

The Trojan boys brought home a total of 34 medals (17 gold, 10 silver, 7 bronze) and won the meet scoring 164 points. Smith Center was second with 132 points and Republic County was third with 88 points.

The gold medal winners for Beloit were Creighton Johnson in the discus with a throw of 163'0", Vincent Palen in the triple jump at 42'3 1/4" and the 110m high hurdles in 16.2, Colin Chandler in the shot put at 51'4 1/2", Zach Meier in the 300m hurdles in 40.97, the 4X100m relay team of Zach Meier, Hudson Gray, Trase McQueen, and Vincent Palen in 45.42, the 4X400m freshman relay team of Caylen Chancellor, Caleb Burks, Daniel Reyes, and Braden Burks in 3:58.48, and the 4X100m Weight Relay team of Braden Burks, Brennan Walker, Creighton Johnson, and Colin Chandler in 49.11.

The silver medal winners were Tristen Brummer in the 800m run in 2:14.29, Creighton Johnson in the shot put at 47'11", the 4X800m relay team of Tristen Brummer, Bryce Mason, Jacob Porter, and Daniel Reyes in 9:03.5, and the freshman 4X100m relay team of Caleb Burks, Tate Kadel, Jackson Rexroat, and Caylen Chancellor in 50.26.

The bronze medal winners were Zach Meier in the 110m high hurdles in 16.84, Jacob Porter in the 3200m run in 11:28.44, Vincent Palen in the long jump at 19'11 1/2", and the 4X400m relay team of Hudson Gray, Bryce Mason, Trase McQueen, and Zach Meier in 3:38.27.

The Lady Trojans won a total of 26 medals (16 gold, 5 silver, 5 bronze) and won the meet with 144 points. Phillipsburg was second with 142 points and Marysville was third with 78 points.

The gold medal winners for Beloit were Hayley Burks in the 1600m run in 5:58.23 and the 3200m run in 13:28.18, Blaise Spangler in the pole vault at 10'0", Khylie Mihm in the 300m hurdles at 50.99, the 4X100m Freshman relay team of Kendal Bogner, Haleigh Pearson, Samantha Zimmerman, and Makenzie Travis in 1:00.02, the 4X100m Weight relay team of Jaci Carter, Trinity McMillan, Sage Prochaska, and Caleigh Hewitt in 59.5, and 4X400m Freshman Relay team of Haleigh Pearson, Samantha Zimmerman, Trinity McMillan, and Makenzie Travis in 5:28.9.

The silver medal winners were Avery Johnson in the discus at 101'2", and the 4X100m relay team of Trinity Wagner, Lenae Knight, Hanna Pearson, and Halle Budke in 54.66.

The bronze medal winners were Halle Budke in the 100m dash in 13.93 and the high jump at 4'10", Caleigh Hewitt in the pole vault at 9'6", Avery Johnson in the shot put at 33'6 ½", and Sage Prochaska in the discus at 91'3".

Coach Isbell said "The teams performed very well in the field and on the track. There were several athletes that achieved personal records and they all continue to improve every day. We are still working on getting athletes healthy, both from injuries and sickness. We will continue to shuffle around the events that some of the kids are in and try to find the best fit moving forward".

The next action for the Trojans will be the Belleville Lions Club Invitational on Tuesday, April 16. Due to construction in Belleville, this meet will be held at Concordia. Field events will begin at 10:00am and the 3200m run will begin at 11:00 AM. The running preliminaries start at noon.
