

# **Belleville Lions Club Invitational**

TUESDAY, APRIL 16, 2019

The Beloit Trojans traveled to Concordia on Tuesday, April 16 to participate in the Belleville Lions Club Invitational. This meet has two divisions, an upper division of 2A and 3A schools, which the Trojans competed in, and a lower division of 1A schools.

The Trojan boys brought home a total of 27 medals (10 gold, 10 silver, 7 bronze) and won the meet with 179 points. Marysville was second with 90 points and Nemaha Central was third with 85 points.

Gold medal winners for Beloit were Creighton Johnson in the discus at 145'3", Brennan Walker in the javelin at 160'10", Colin Chandler in the shot put at 50'0", Tristan Brummer in the 1600m run in 5:08.79, Vincent Palen in the 110m high hurdles in 15.67, Zach Meier in the 300m hurdles in 41.1, and the 4X100m relay team of Zach Meier, Hudson Gray, Trase McQueen, and Vincent Palen in 45.74.

Silver medal winners were Trase McQueen in the 300m dash in 54.9, Jacob Porter in the 3200m run in 11:28.48, Zach Meier in the 110m high hurdles in 16.1, Creighton Johnson in the shot put at 45'9", Colin Chandler in the discus at 140'9", Bryce Mason in the javelin at 157'8", and the 4X800m relay team of Daniel Reyes, Jacob Porter, Bryce Mason, and Tristan Brummer in 9:19.55.

Bronze medal winners were Vincent Palen in the long jump at 19'10.25" and the triple jump at 40'8.5", Jace Walker in the 100m dash in 12.13, and the 4X400m relay team of Trase McQueen, Tristan Brummer, Bryce Mason, and Zach Meier in 3:41.67.

The Lady Trojans brought home a total of 12 medals (2 gold, 4 silver, 6 bronze) and finished third with 93.5 points. Nemaha Central won the meet with 109.5 points and Marysville was second with 97 points.

Gold medal winners for Beloit were Hayley Burks in the 3200m run in 12:49.73 and Blaise Spangler in the pole vault at 10'0".

Silver medal winners were Hayley Burks in the 1600m run in 5:45.58, Khylie Mihm in the 300m hurdles in 52.16, and Caleigh Hewitt and Trista Boeve tied in the pole vault at 9'6".

Bronze medal winners were Avery Johnson in the shot put at 35'3", Trinity McMillan in the javelin at 112'0", and the 4X800m relay team of Khylie Mihm, Samantha Zimmerma, Reagan Eilert, and Hayley Burks in 11:50.13.

The next action for the Trojan track teams will be the Phillipsburg meet held on Thursday, April 18. The field events will begin at 3:00pm and running finals will start at 6:00pm.
