

# CONCORDIA INVITATIONAL TRACK MEET

Friday, April 5, 2019

The Trojan track teams traveled to Concordia for the Concordia Invitational track meet held on Friday, April 5. This meet saw the Trojans run up against some very tough competition from the likes of Concordia, Clay Center, Buhler, Marysville, Sacred Heart, Southern Cloud, Smith Center, Solomon and Hope.

When asked about the athlete's overall performances, coach Isbell said “The kids took advantage of the opportunity and stepped up and competed very well. Most of the athletes had personal best times, distances, and heights. There is work to do, but we are very pleased with our progress to this point”.

The Trojan boy's brought home a total of 17 medals (5 gold, 12 silver) and won the meet with 117 points. Smith Center was second with 110 points and Marysville was third with 81 points.

The gold medal winners for Beloit were Vincent Palen in the 110m high hurdles in 16.3 and the triple jump at 41'1”, Creighton Johnson in the discus with a throw of 160'7”, Colin Chandler in the shot put at 49'8”, and Zach Meier in the 300m hurdles in 41.97.

The silver medal winners were Hudson Gray in the triple jump at 40'10 ¾”, Vincent Palen in the long jump at 20'9 ¾”, Creighton Johnson in the shot put at 46'5 ½”, Zach Meier in the 110m high hurdles in 16.69, the 4X100m relay team of Zach Meier, Hudson Gray, Trase McQueen, and Vincent Palen in a time of 46.09, and the 4X400m relay team of Hudson Gray, Bryce Mason, Trase McQueen, and Zach Meier in a time of 3:37.59.

The Lady Trojans brought home a total of 10 medals (2 gold, 6 silver, 2 bronze) and won the meet with 95 points. Buhler and Marysville tied for second with 80 points.

Gold medal winners for Beloit were Halle Budke in the high jump at 4'10” and Avery Johnson in the discus with a throw of 102'2”.

The silver medal winners were Hannah Burks in the 1600m run in 5:58.01 and the 3200m run in 12:55.91, Khyllie Mihm in the 300m hurdles in 52.39, Hanna Pearson in the high jump at 4'10”, Blaise Spangler in the pole vault at 10'0”, and Sage Prochaska in the discus at 98'11”.

The bronze medal winners were Avery Johnson in the shot put at 31'9”, and Caleigh Hewitt in the pole vault at 9'0”.

The next action for the Beloit Trojan varsity track teams will be the Redman Relays at Smith Center on Tuesday, April 9. Field events will start at 3:00, preliminaries at 4:00, and the running event finals will begin 30 minutes following the preliminaries.
